

# Cross Tab Report



## To create a Cross Tab report:

1. In the Report Manager Tab select your survey and click on the **Cross Tab** icon
2. Choose the questions you want as your horizontal and vertical variables
3. Click the **Generate Report**
4. Customize your report

This report allows for the cross-tabulation of two or three questions to view possible correlations
